School Appointments



Applications must be submitted for consideration of affiliate preceptor or voluntary faculty appointment. Affiliate preceptors gain access to online resources, special rates for SPPS events, and are provided opportunities to participate in pharmacy student community health activities, such as health fairs and mentoring.

Library Access

Preceptors who maintain active status as affiliate or volunteer faculty will receive access to the University of California electronic library utilizing VPN (Virtual Private Network). These resources include clinical databases and online journal access.



Continuing Education Events



Preceptors will be given opportunities for educational events, including independent study and/or live continuing education sessions, as well as annual preceptor development.

Conference Attendance

Volunteer faculty or affiliate preceptors may be eligible for registration reimbursement for attendance at national or regional conferences, and may also be eligible for sponsored poster printing. Applications must be submitted through the Office of Experiential Education prior to conference attendance.



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
